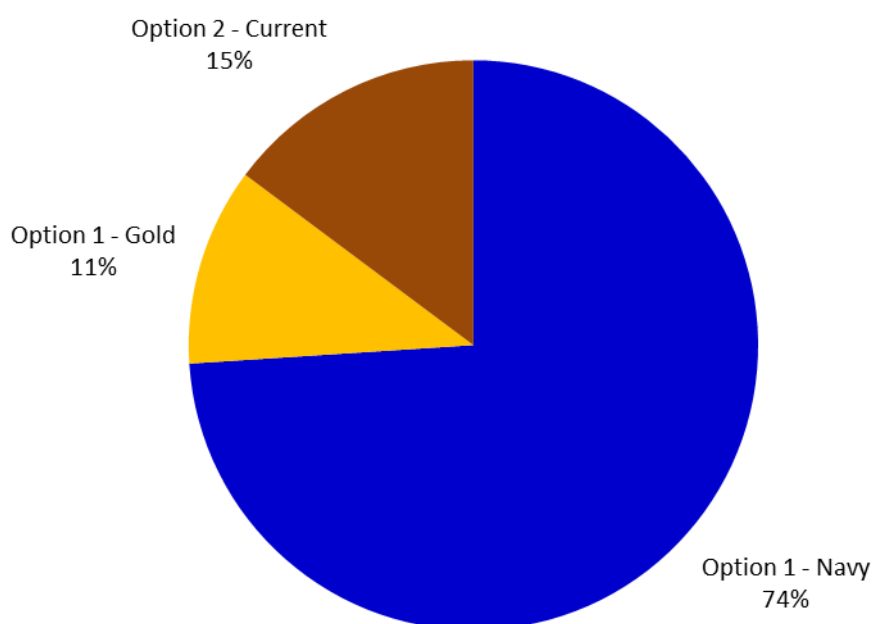

During Week 8 students from Yeoval, Peak Hill and Trundle attended Yeoval Central School to fabricate a 6x4 Box Trailer. Thanks to Damien Sharah, Shannon Gane from Peak Hill and the Yeoval District Baptist Church in supporting the students to produce an outstanding trailer of high quality.



The trailer features: *2.1mm thick checker plate floor instead of 1.6mm ; 75x50mm draw bar instead of 40x40mm; Fabricated and welded Toolbox; Ladder racks at front and back ; Gusset plates to reinforce the wheel guards; 40x40 Square Hollow Section underfloor reinforcing every 600mm; LED lights; 7 Pin plug; 750kg load rating.*

On Friday 11 October representatives from Newcrest-Cadia Mining Company and the NSW Minerals Council visited Yeoval Central School and presented students with an Enviro-Smart award. The award recognised the achievements of students in Years 9 and 10 Geography and Agriculture in the field of soil and water conservation. As part of this initiative students attended an excursion to Don Bruce's farm at Cumnock and carried out a number of soil and water tests. Students evaluated management strategies to improve the land and observed changes to salinity affected areas. Students outlined their project to the mining personnel and demonstrated a sound depth of knowledge about soil and water conservation.
