## WELLINGTON EISTEDDFOD

Last week saw a number of our primary and secondary students travel to Wellington on 2 days for the choir and instrumental sections.

On Tuesday, our primary choir sang 'Fireworks' and 'The Climb'. The adjudicator commented on the choir's discipline and focus on the conductor, Kate Border. They were awarded 1<sup>st</sup> place in their section.

The secondary choir sang 'Over the Sea to Skye' and 'Joyful, Joyful'. Despite a major technical hitch, the girls coped admirably and impressed the adjudicator with their musicality and adaptability. They were awarded 1<sup>st</sup> place in their section with a score of 92%.

We celebrated both our wins with a picnic lunch in the park and ice blocks, as well as a play on the play equipment.

Thursday saw another excited bus load of students head to the Civic centre for the Instrumental section.

Years 3/4 amazed the audience with their percussion performance on chairs to the song 'We will

Rock You'. Mrs Klein was extremely proud of her class, as they took out 2<sup>nd</sup> place with a score of 90%.

The Recorder group, made up of 9 Year 5/6 students, beautifully performed a traditional folk song 'Over the Sea to Skye'. This group came 2<sup>nd</sup> with a high score of 90%.

The Drum Corp stunned the adjudicator with their precision and accuracy, taking out 1<sup>st</sup> place with a score of 92%.

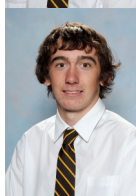
