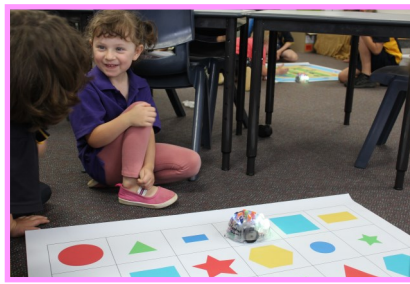
Our students were involved in several **extra-curricula activities** last week. I would like to thank the following staff who either coordinated or attended to support our students:

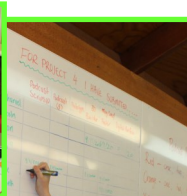

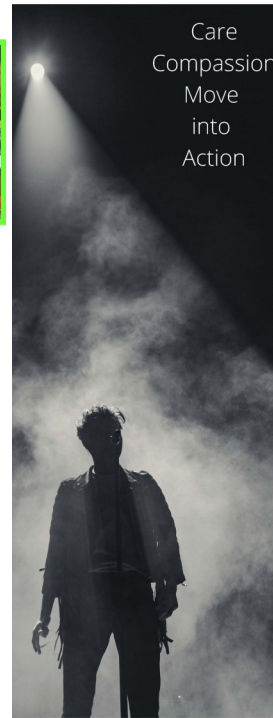
