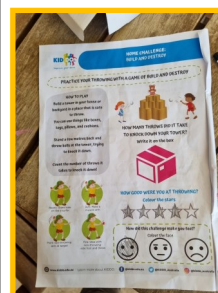
Lastly, an activity book with many different activities including a family scavenger hunt. Primary students are wished good luck in their physical activity journey whilst at home.

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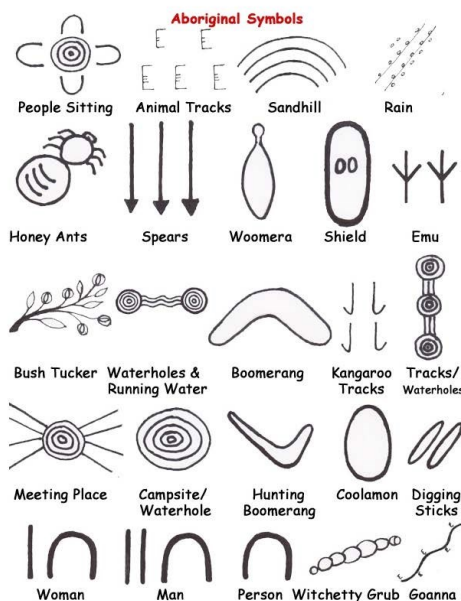
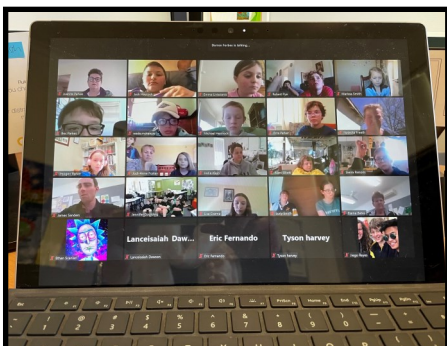
NAIDOC DAY

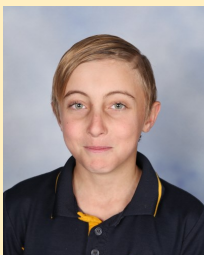
