and students.



Stage 6: Primary Industries





The Year 11 Western Access Primary Industries class has been working on the Weather and Chemical clusters this term.

The warm weather has lead to an explosion of pest species- both plant and insects. Students have been putting together a weed and feed plant

collection to help with future identification of weed species. Yeoval Central School's roses have developed a large infestation of aphids.

We take our PPE (personal protective equipment) seriously, ensuring that Dominic and Samuel were fully decked

out to tackle the aphid problem using eco-oil. Eco-oil is a registered organic miticide and insecticide. It controls a range of problem insects including scale, aphids, two-spotted mite, whitefly, mealybugs and citrus leafminer. Safe for use on veggies, as well as ornamentals, with no withholding period. Spray and eat on the same day! *Mr Ken Horley*
