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Intensive Swimming



All primary students participated in 2 weeks of Intensive swimming during weeks 8 and 9. YCS was very fortunate to have this program fully funded and have five AUSTSWIM trained teachers who were dedicated to help our students succeed in the water.

While some students were learning to swim and become confident in the water other students were working on survival skills and how to perform rescues safely.



9/10 Virtual Work Experience

In Week 8 our 9/10 students had the opportunity to participate in a virtual Work Experience program held at school. As students were unable to complete work experience due to current DOE guidelines this was an excellent alternative for them.

Over the two days students worked on various activities using our interactive Career Tools and Job Jump websites as well as participating in a variety of zoom sessions. Students had an informative zoom with Charles Sturt University as well as TAFE NSW, where



students were given insight into study at both institutions, the enrolment process, study and career options plus an informative question and answer session.



Students also participated in small group zooms with a variety of industry professionals as part of the eBeacon Foundation's - My Road Mentoring Program. The program is aimed at building transferable work-readiness skills and selfconfidence around the world of work.


