Life Education is designed to cover the PDHPE outcomes in student learning in K-6.

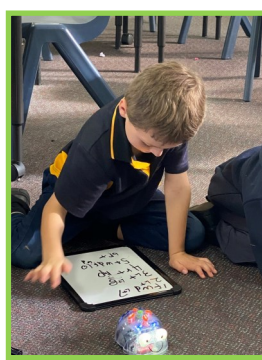
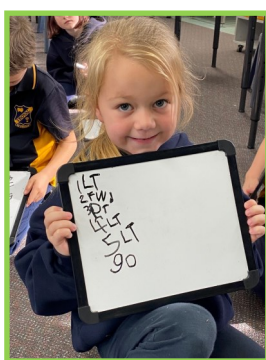
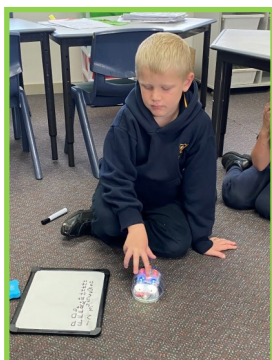
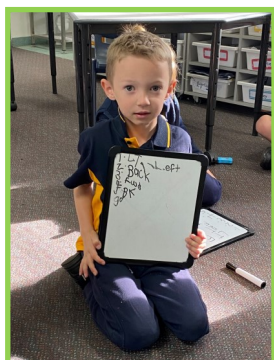

Students sat around the camp fire and learnt about Dundullimal hunting, totems and how people would come together to discuss the consequences for inappropriate behaviour, such as taking more than was needed.
