TRANSITION PROGRAMS

Yeoval Central School has two transition programs in place to assist students prepare for kindergarten and Year 7.

This Wednesday is the first Year 7 Transition Day for 2023, giving Year 5/6 students a taste of secondary schooling at YCS. A parent information session will be held from 9am-10am, while students will participate in secondary subjects throughout the day. This is the first of multiple transition days that will be held throughout the year in the lead-up to 2024.

This year we have five children enrolled so far in our Little Eagles transition program, which gives pre-school children aged 3-5 years some exposure to 'big school.' On Mondays of the school term between 11.30am and 3pm, children who can toilet independently are invited to attend YCS to develop school readiness skills and to engage in play-based learning experiences.
