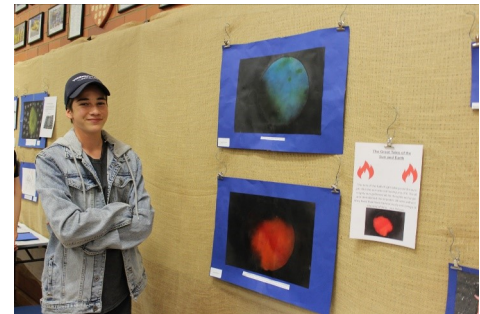

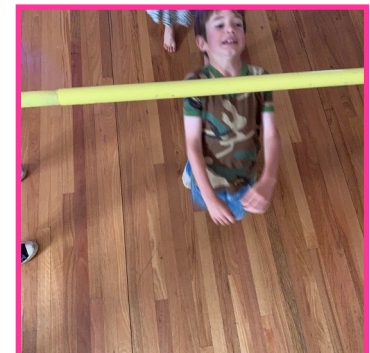
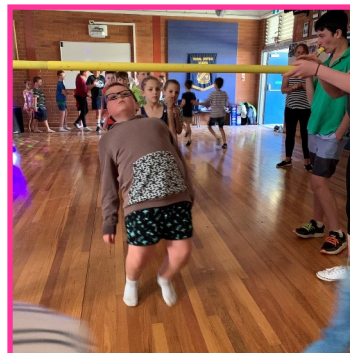
## SRC Drought Relief Disco
